## **How to Apply**

We are thrilled that you have chosen to apply to State Line Christian School. Since its establishment in 1973, State Line Christian School has worked to teach and train the next generation. Our purpose has always been to provide a first-class, Christ-centered education. If what we believe, teach, and practice is what you desire for your children, then use the following application process to enroll your child.

### **1. Apply for Admission**

State Line Christian School is committed to making Christian education available to those who desire it. An application can be picked up from our school office or you may fill out the application online. Please complete the entire application and submit it to us either by mail or online.

### **2. Interview with the Principal**

Following your application submittal, you will be contacted by our school office (usually within a week) to set up an interview with our principal. We recommend that both parents be at this meeting. Also, if the student is going into second through twelfth grade, they should attend this meeting.

In order for a prospective student to be enrolled, the parent(s) and student(s) must be in agreement about enrolling in State Line Christian School. All parents and all junior high and senior high school students must sign a statement of cooperation.

The following forms should be brought to this interview:

- A. Copies of the student's birth certificate and vaccination records
- B. Copies of the student's last report card and standardized test scores (if transferring during the school year—a grade withdrawal form)
- C. Discipline records from the previous school

Students transferring from non-traditional schools (home schools, P.A.C.E programs, etc.) are required to provide a notarized statement of grade level(s) and/or courses passed.

### **3. Acceptance**

After steps one and two have been completed, you will receive a timely notification of your child's acceptance to State Line Christian School.

## 4. Enrollment

Enrollment opens in February of the current year. We encourage you to enroll as early as possible as classes fill up quickly.

## 5. Student Testing

It is our goal that every child be successful at State Line Christian School. After the interview, a test time will be set up with you. This testing will allow us to make sure we have the right fit and placement of your student. It also enables our faculty to know your student's strengths and weaknesses. Depending on the results of the testing, he may be asked to repeat the last grade. Assessment testing will only apply to new students entering grades four through twelve.

There is a non-refundable testing fee of \$50.00 for each student tested.

### ➤ General Information

All prospective kindergarten students (K4 and K5) must be four and five years of age, respectively by November 1<sup>st</sup> of the present year.

All students should faithfully attend all the services of a Bible-believing church.

Final acceptance is contingent upon receiving and reviewing records from the previous school attended and the results of any necessary testing.

We do offer bus transportation at select locations: one in Monroe and the other in Toledo-near Perrysburg.
